Kennedy gave all of herself to family in the final weeks. Giving each family member a small piece of herself. Since the inception of the Dr. Marnie Rose Foundation, your incredible generosity has truly made a difference. Your donations, totaling over \$7 million dollars, have been nothing short of transformative.

At MD Anderson specifically, your donations have funded numerous projects within the Brain Tumor Center, spanning twenty-seven research laboratories, and providing researchers with cutting-edge technology, including the Confocal Microscope that provides critical 3D imaging.

In February, we had the privilege of meeting with Dr. Lang, Dr. Puduvalli, Dr. Fueyo, and Dr. Gomez-Manzano to discuss how your generous contributions can directly impact the development of future treatments for brain cancer patients. It was an inspiring discussion, fueled by our shared hope of finding a cure. Together, we created a plan to allocate funds towards two new, complementary programs and a new microscope that we know will help get us closer to finding a cure.

The first program streamlines the acquisition and analysis of biospecimens from each brain tumor patient seen at MD Anderson, and enables the discovery of new targets and the development of novel therapeutics. All of this can happen with no time lost, as samples do not need to be transported to third-party labs for testing. This program continues to build a vital biospecimen bank which serves as a beacon of hope for researchers and clinicians alike, providing crucial resources for research and clinical trials dedicated to finding cures for brain cancer.

The second program supports preclinical research efforts across the Brain Tumor Center by providing centralized and specialized modeling, which enables uniform and reproducible experimentation.

Lastly, your donations will enable the purchase of a new microscope that is capable of live cell kinetic imaging. This microscope will allow researchers to grow and analyze cells over time because it has built-in environmental controls to maintain live cells and kinetic analysis software, thus enabling a better understanding of brain tumor cells and their microenvironment. These initiatives mark significant strides in our mission.

Your generosity is the driving force behind these transformative gifts and their profound impact on the lives of countless individuals affected by brain cancer. Thank you for your continued support in this journey towards a cure.
